Introduction

Spectrum CIC, are the lead provider of the integrated sexual health services across the Wigan Borough. The range of services offered includes:

1. All methods of contraception, including emergency contraception.
2. Screening and tests for Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs), including Chlamydia, HIV and treatments for most STIs.
3. Vaccinations for Hepatitis A and B.
4. Advice on unplanned pregnancy and other sexual health issues
5. Spectrum, also provide Relationship and Sex Education (RSE) in schools across the borough and are responsible for the delivery of the C Card (condom card) Condom Distribution Scheme across the borough.

The integrated sexual health clinics are located at Wigan Galleries and at Leigh Health Centre Entrance C.
