During your stay in hospital, you were reviewed by a member of the Acute Oncology team.

The Acute Oncology Service has been developed to support patients with cancer who come to hospital as an emergency. This could be because of a complication from cancer treatment, symptoms related to cancer, or because a patient has had a scan that suggests they may have a new cancer.
