Unfortunately, at this time the Trust do not have a defined pathway but are collectively working on developing one based on British Thoracic Society and NICE guidelines.

If yes, please provide when the current Bronchiectasis pathway was implemented. Are they
based on the NICE and British Thoracic Guidelines? Is physiotherapy a key part in your
trusts acute Bronchiectasis management? Since implementation, are more patients being
referred to physiotherapy? Has there been an improvement in patient
outcomes/management of bronchiectasis? Pre and post implementation, what are the
referral statistics to physiotherapists?
