With reference to your request for information received on 17th October 2024, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

- 1. In the last 12 months of data that you have available, how many patients were treated for wet AMD (wet age-related macular degeneration) (ICD-10 Code H35.30) with the following agents:**
 - a. **Bevacizumab** = 0.
 - b. **Faricimab** = 356.
 - c. **Ranibizumab** = 71.
 - d. **Aflibercept** = 383.

- 2. If possible to answer, in the last 12 months of data that you have available, how many other ophthalmology patients have you treated with the following agents (please list how many for each agent separately):**
 - a. **Bevacizumab** = 87.
 - b. **Faricimab** = 541.
 - c. **Ranibizumab** = 247.
 - d. **Aflibercept** = 1203.
