With reference to your request for information received on 18th October 2024, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold part of the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

I would be grateful if you could please provide me your responses to the following two queries relating to management of Paediatrics patients at your respective trusts.

- Does your Paediatric department manage young people aged 16 years to 17 years and 364 days for <u>acute</u> medical, surgical or mental health issues ? (Please note this does not include CYP already under your care for on-going treatment of related condition/s). Yes.
- 2. If yes, would you be able to share your SOP for this cohort of patients (aged between 16 years and 17 years 364 days only) ?

There is no agreed SOP as the deviations from the 16-year rule are all built on an individual basis. We accept that some patients have extensive ongoing care with the paediatric team and as such they are still cared for after 16 during their transition to adult care. We also accept that some patients over the age of 16 are appropriately cared for in children's services rather than adult ones because of their vulnerability or other characteristics. And the Department take a pragmatic agreement for the minority of cases.
