 - Myelofibrosis (ICD10 code D47.4) 8

- Q3. How many patients were treated in the past 6 months (for any disease) with:
 - Ruxolitinib 8
 - Fedratinib 0
- Q4. Of the patients treated in the past 6 months with Ruxolitinib, how many patients had a diagnosis for:
 - Polycythaemia Vera (ICD10 code D45) 0
 - Myelofibrosis (ICD10 code D47.4) 8

Q5. How many myelofibrosis (ICD10 code D47.4) patients has your trust diagnosed in the past 3 years? 53

- Of these patients, how many were treated in the past 6 months with Hydroxycarbamide?
- Of these patients, how many were treated in the past 6 months with Interferon therapy? 0
- Of these patients, how many have received no active treatment in the past 6 months? 0
