## Section 43(2) - Commercial interests.

(2) Information is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to, prejudice the commercial interests of any person (including the public authority holding it). Section 43(2) is a qualified exemption and subject to the prejudice test and the public interest test. Under the prejudice test we must consider if disclosure of this information would, or would be likely to, prejudice our commercial interests or the commercial interests of a third party. Consideration is also given to the harm disclosing this information would be likely to cause, combined with other information already in the public domain (mosaic effect) or possibly released at a future date (precedent effect). The public interest test considers and balances the public interest in disclosing this information against the public interest in not disclosing this information and uses this assessment to decide whether there is sufficient justification in withholding this information under this exemption. Information disclosed under the FOIA is considered to be public information, and while there is a presumption towards disclosure, consideration needs to be given as to who will have access to this information beyond the requestor and the purposes for which they could use the information.

### Prejudice to commercial interests

The Trust has examined the impact of releasing the information withheld under Section 43 (2) in order to decide if disclosure would be likely to prejudice our commercial interests or the commercial interests of a third party. The information required to provide a response regarding the spend for each product is contractually confidential and would be likely to prejudice the commercial interests of ourselves and those who intend to tender for this service.

#### **Public Interest Test**

There is, of course, a public interest in promoting transparency of public authorities' decisions and accountability, however, the disclosure of the information currently withheld under this exemption would be likely to prejudice commercial interests of the Trust as it will reveal details which would be likely impact on future spending and also prejudice our ability to effectively negotiate and achieve best value for the public purse.

It is the view of the Trust that, at this time, the public interest in withholding the information outweighs the public interest in disclosing it.
