Could you please tell me for the years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023 [current number as of 9th October]:

The number of A&E attendances where the word 'cocaine' appears in records

There were 13 instances where A&E attendance records contained the word "cocaine" or a variation of it. These all occurred between January and June 2018. These records are the perception of the staff assessing the patient when they presented at A&E and therefore may not be relevant to the final diagnosis for treatment

The number of A&E attendances where the word 'ketamine' appears in records
